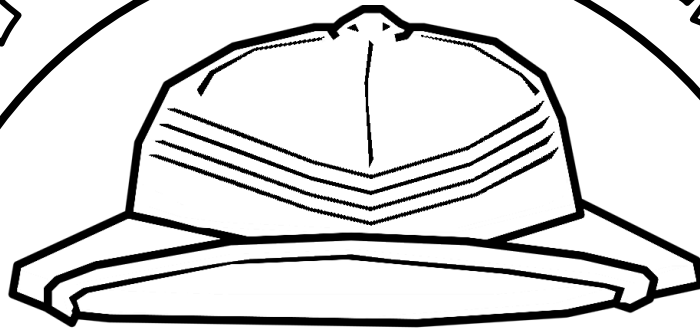

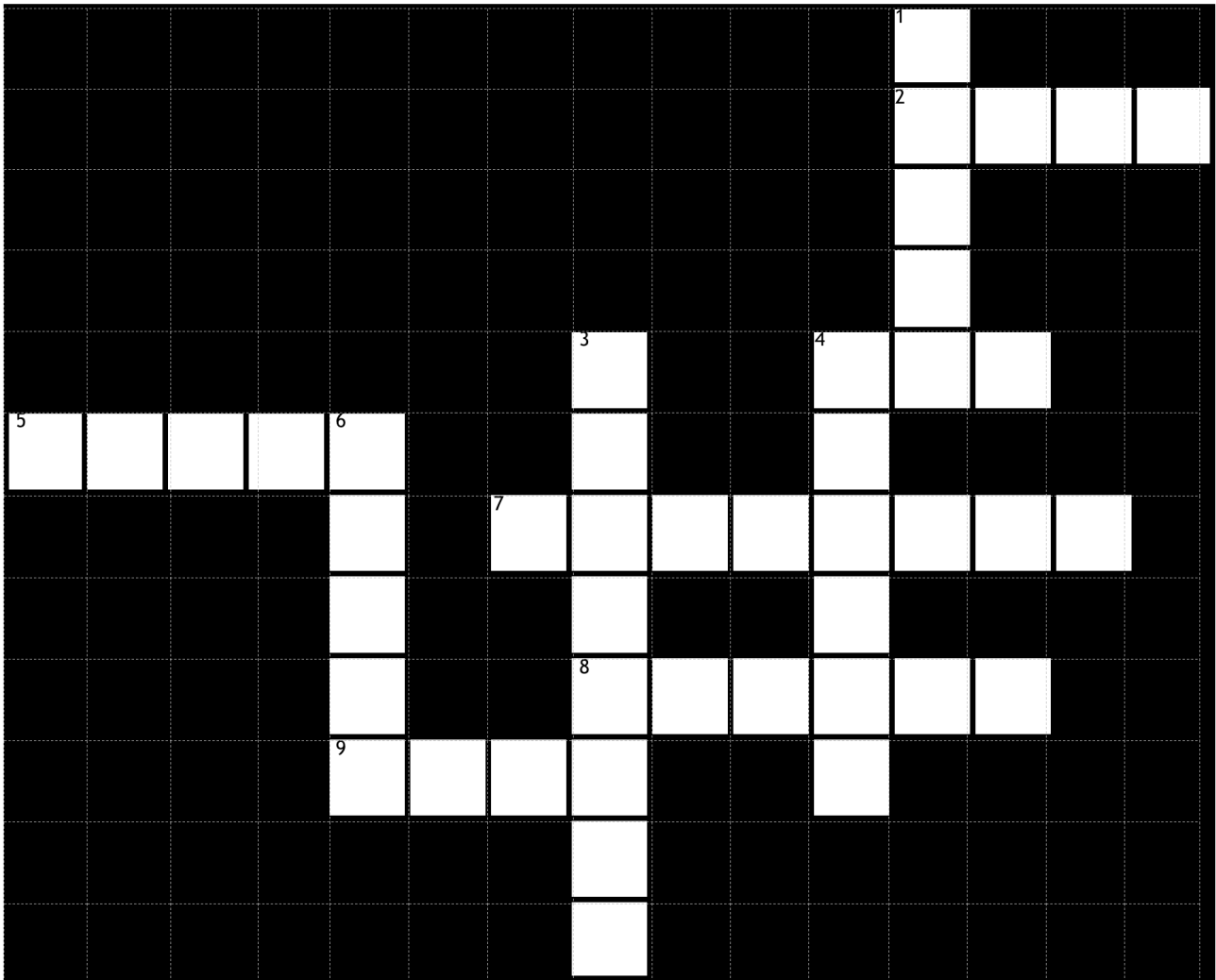

Critter Crossword!



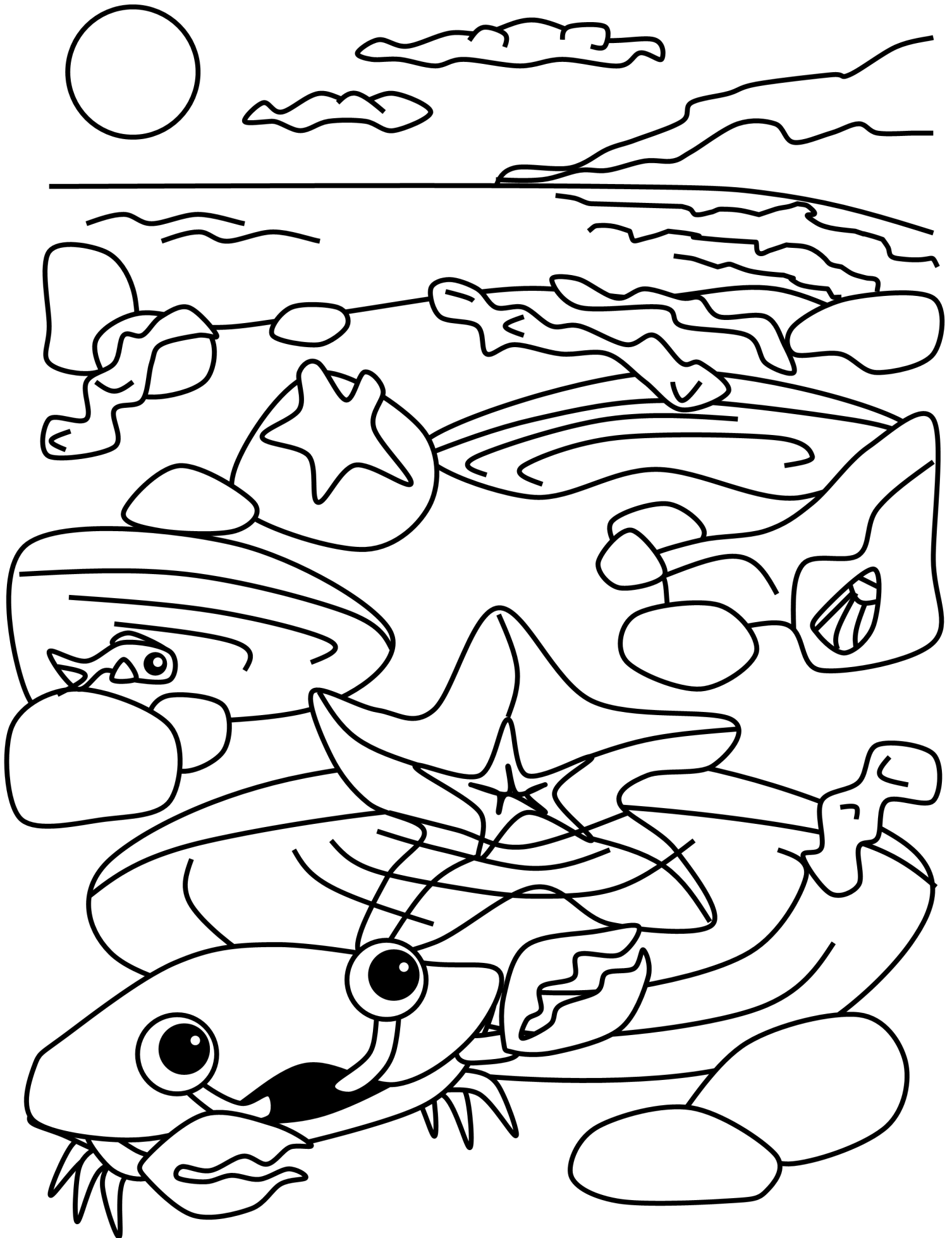

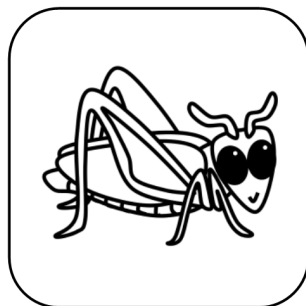
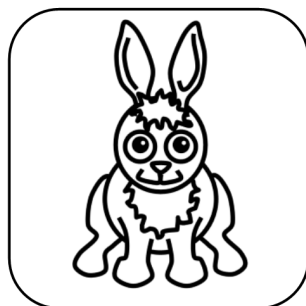
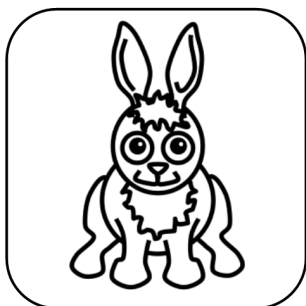
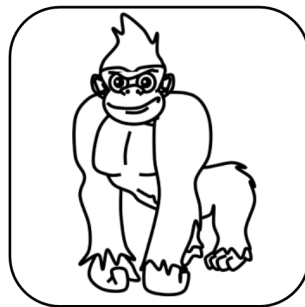
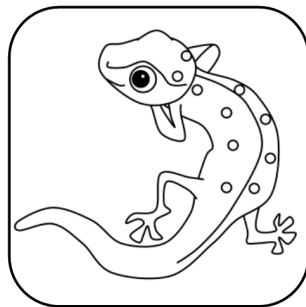
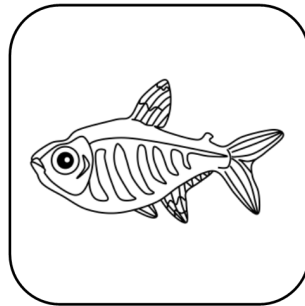
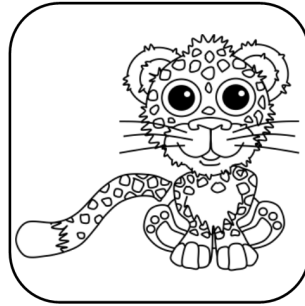
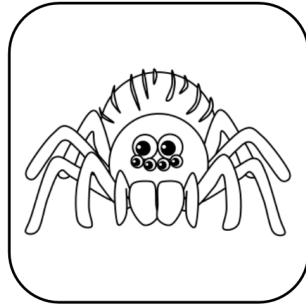


Critter Memory Match-up!
